#### 2. OBJECTIVE OF THE POLICY

The Group Fleet Policy provides high-level guidance on how to transition Solar's fleet to become 100% electrical/hybrid. The reference is the EV100 principles of the Climate Group.

#### 3. POLICY

Solar is committed to following global and local rules, regulations and standards that support a sustainable fleet transition and aims to cause the least possible harm to daily life.

Overall Group Fleet Policy and targets towards 2030:

- 100% of cars up to 3.5 t to be electrical/hybrid cars
- 50% of cars between 3.5 t 7.5 t to be electrical/hybrid cars

EV chargers at Solar premises shall preferable be powered by renewable or green energy.

As of 2021, all employees will be offered the opportunity to choose an electrical/hybrid car within their car category. Fossil driven cars shall comply with class A.
